 my son coms of age within 2 years after the
 coms of age the first year to pay five pounds to you to my
 Daughters Hannah and the 2 years following five pounds
 a year to my Daughters Sarah — that Charles in
 the bequeath my whole estate to my wife during here
 natural life is to be under stand till my sons coms of
 age of 21 years the words to my wife contained
 in here unto of my last will and testament I get to my
 hand and seal in the presence of thys witness
